✔ LOCATIONS FROM TEXAS TO FLORIDA & NORTH TO MA, NJ, VA, SC, KY, IN, OH, WI, AND IA

✓ AROUND 200 CHURCHES STRONG (PLUS 20 IN MEXICO)

✓ FINANCIALLY SECURE AND ACCOUNTABLE

✓ HEALTH AND RETIREMENT BENEFITS AVAILABLE TO ALL CHURCH MINISTERS/EMPLOYEES

✓ NO HIERARCHICAL STRUCTURE (ELECTED POSITIONS)
